This privacy notice explains how we use your personal information and your rights regarding that information. Not all the information we received or collect is personal information (e.g. company information). What constitutes personal information can be found here.

What information are we collecting?

The level of information collected depends on the level of engagement that you have with the Event.

Applicant to Participate in the Food Security and Resilience Copernicus Hackathon

Your personal information is collected when you register to participate in this Event in accordance with the Terms of Participation.

If you register with the Event we receive the mandatory information you are required to provide to set up your account which includes personal contact details (Salutation, First and Second names) your email address as well as your company name and address location, your country of residence, your main skills and, where relevant, the name of your team. You may voluntarily provide us with additional personal information as part of your participation in the Event.

The information we collect from you is used to enable us to contact you about and manage your participation in the Event. If you are not already part of a team we will use your information to enable us to match you up with other participants to create a 'team' for the Event.

Our mailing list is managed by Eventbrite (<https://www.eventbrite.co.uk/>) and you have full control over your subscription to the Event via their services.

Contact

If you contact us through the website, or directly through the Food Security and Resilience Copernicus Hackathon management team or the University of Leicester staff then we will collect your contact details as well as your company name, location and your reason for contacting us. This information is collected so that we can respond to your enquiry or contact you about the Event including registration, sponsorship etc. as appropriate.

Anonymised information may be used to promote the Event and to fulfil our reporting obligations with our funder.

Why are we processing your data?

The purpose of this data collection is to communicate with you about the Event where you are enquiring about it and to enable us to deliver the Event where you have registered to participate in it.

How will we use this data?

Your data will be used to for the delivery of the Event, to enable us to manage your participation in the Event, including your interaction with the expert challengers, sponsors, assessment by the Panel and your receipt of any prize or award as part of this programme as well as to communicate with you about any future opportunities arising from the event.

What is the legal basis for processing the data?

The legal bases for processing your data is the performance of a contract under Art 6 GDPR namely your participation in the Food Security and Resilience Copernicus Hackathon. Where you provide us with additional personal information voluntarily we will be processing that personal data on the basis of your consent.

If we are sharing your data with others who are we sharing it with?

Personal information collected when you registered and any additional data we collect from you with your consent may be shared with the European Commission(EC), as funder, and AZO the Coordinator in charge of implementing the Copernicus Hackathon Programme on behalf of the European Commission. If you are an award winner we will share your information with the EC, AZO and the relevant sponsors of awards and prizes at the event. Awards that require the winner to enter into a separate contract with the awarding body /company are not covered by this privacy notice.

Anonymised information may be shared with organisations contributing to the delivery of the Event and to fulfil our reporting obligations with our funder.

How long we will process your data for?

We will process your data for as long as is necessary for the purpose of the Food Security and Resilience Copernicus Hackathon event, to meet our contractual obligations with AZO and in accordance with our retention periods for the personal data we hold about you are described in the [University Records Retention Schedules](#), whichever is the later.

What are your rights?

Your rights in respect of personal data processing under the performance of a contract are:
